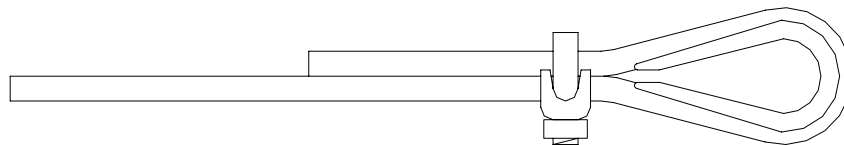


PORTA-DOCK LIFTS

ALTHOUGH YOUR PORTA-DOCK ALUMINUM LIFT IS MAINTENANCE FREE, THERE ARE SOME THINGS THE OWNER CAN DO TO INSURE SMOOTH AND SAFE OPERATION.

1. Your winch comes from the factory properly greased. Each season apply automotive grease to the gear teeth and drum bearings. BE CAREFUL not to get grease on the brake pads. Use light oil on ratchet, bushings, and pinion threads. Brake disc should be replaced if cracked, broken, or less than 1/16" thick. REMEMBER, when cranking cable in, there should be a loud clicking sound and no clicking sound when cranking cable out.
2. The cable should be wiped with a light oil, and checked for frays, brakes, or kinks. Make sure cable clamp is properly installed (picture below) and tightened.



3. Pulleys should be lubricated with a light oil and checked to see that the cable is in the pulley groove.
4. Finally, check all fasteners to be sure they are tight and show no signs of wear and tear.

WHEN STORING YOUR PORTA-DOCK LIFT, USE A LIGHT OIL ON THE CABLE AND PULLEYS AND COVER THE WINCH.
